As such, all color and slide film processing will cease as of Saturday, January 30, 2010, as will printing from film of any kind.

Printing from digital files on CDs, camera cards and internet orders from our web site will continue through most of February.

The Frame Depot, a division of The Photo Depot, will be ceasing its operations as well.

In addition to the print services on the internet, we are excited to be offering a new pick up and delivery service in the Moon/Sewickley/Ambridge area for scanning your slides and shoeboxes full of photos. We'll turn them into digital files and give them to you on a CD or DVD along with your originals. These files can also be made into a slide show for viewing on any DVD or BlueRay player. We will also continue to offer video transfer to DVD for your VHS and camcorder tapes. Details will be published shortly on the web site.

Throughout all these years we have seen your children being born, your family birthday parties, Christmas and Thanksgiving celebrations, vacations, children on their first day of school and then eventually off to college, and finally the weddings—with the cycle starting over again with your grandchildren and the next generation.
